

Filling in Interactive Seasearch PDF Forms

Interactive Seasearch surveyor and observer forms in PDF format are available on the Seasearch web site. <https://www.seasearch.org.uk/recording-data/>

In order to use the interactive functionality of these forms you need to pay attention to how you do this.

1. Download the form from the Seasearch web site and SAVE IT TO A LOCATION ON YOUR COMPUTER where you can find it again.
2. Do not simply open the form in your browser and attempt to fill it on-line. You will not be able to save the information you have input and **you will lose your work**.
3. Download and install the free Adobe Acrobat Reader app from the Adobe web site. Other PDF readers may not interpret the form correctly.
4. For PCs see here <https://www.adobe.com/uk/acrobat/pdf-reader.html> For Mac OS scroll down this page to "*More download options*" and select the appropriate OS. If you are working from a MAC you may be taken directly to the appropriate app for your system.
5. MAC/iPad users MUST download and use the free Adobe Acrobat Reader app from the Adobe web site in order to open the forms. The interactive forms DO NOT work if they are opened in the default MAC PDF viewer app called Preview.
6. Open the form in Adobe Acrobat Reader (not directly on line in your browser), fill it in as required and save it to your computer.
7. If this still does not work make sure that you have indeed downloaded the interactive version of the form, not the version to be printed on paper.
